# Protests erupt in Kashmir on sixth anniversary of Article 370 abrogation

Political party leaders claimed that police did not allow them to leave their headquarters

Protests erupted across Jammu and Kashmir on Tuesday as political parties marked the sixth anniversary of the abrogation of Article 370 by demanding the restoration of statehood and the region's special constitutional status.

On August 5, 2019, the Centre had revoked Jammu and Kashmir's special status under Article 370 of the Constitution and bifurcated the region into two union territories — Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.

While Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah have pledged to restore statehood, the region continues to function as an UT with limited powers.

The police on Tuesday prevented protest marches planned by both the National Conference (NC) and the

People's Democratic Party (PDP) in Srinagar, the summer capital of the region.

**'HELDOUS STAGE'**  
Dozens of NC leaders and workers assembled at the party headquarters, Nawa-i-Subah, and attempted to march towards Lal Chowk, the city's commercial hub.

"We were not allowed to leave the office," an NC worker told *businessline*.

Protesters carried placards that read "August 5, 2019 unacceptable" and "Restore our democratic rights", and chanted slogans calling for the reinstatement of Article 370 and full statehood.

PDP workers also prevented from leaving their headquarters. "We were imprisoned in the PDP office like animals," said PDP leader Iltija Mufti, adding that Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) vehicles had been stationed outside their office to stop them from moving out.

"There has been no change on the ground since the abrogation," she said. "Over the past week, rumours have been circulating about separating Jammu from Kashmir, merging South Kashmir with it, and granting it statehood."

Ahead of the anniversary, rumour mills were ablaze, with speculation about the possible restoration of full statehood or further bifurcation of the region.

In both Srinagar and

Jammu, Congress workers held peaceful demonstrations demanding the return of full statehood. It observed today as a "black day".

"People of Jammu and Kashmir feel as if they are living as second-class citizens in their own country," said Tariq Hameed Karra, State president of the Jammu and Kashmir Pradesh Congress Committee (JKPC), while addressing protesters.

The Congress has already launched a campaign, *Hamari Riyasat, Hamara Haq* (Our State, Our Right), urging the Centre to restore statehood.

Meanwhile, workers of the Bharatiya Janata Party celebrated the anniversary of the Article 370 abrogation in the region.

# Kerala opposes Offshore Areas Atomic Minerals Rules 2025

The Kerala government has opposed the Centre's decision to allow private sector participation in offshore atomic minerals mining, saying that would severely impact the marine ecosystem, livelihood of coastal communities and jeopardise national security.

Industries Minister P Rajeev has sought the Centre's withdrawal of the Offshore Areas Atomic Minerals Rules 2025, which includes a provision to grant permission to the private sector to mine and explore nuclear minerals like thorium and uranium in India's EEZ.

"This is a unilateral move by the Centre. Despite the fact that atomic mineral-rich seabeds lie off Kerala's coast, no consultation was held with the State. It is a clear violation of federal principles and an encroachment on constitutional rights," the minister said in a statement.
